

Common goal for the use of antibiotics

IFAH-Europe proposes the following common goal with all stakeholders:

'The common goal is to protect public health, animal health and welfare and to ensure that antibiotics are effective now and in the future for relevant indications in all species.'

How to Achieve the Goal

- Responsible Use = use in the context of bio-security, good housing, good nutrition, appropriate vaccination and use, as required by law, under the prescription of a veterinarian

- Transparency at the use phase
 - Provide electronic data from the veterinarian to the authorities on use by farm
 - With data on animal numbers by farm, authorities can ensure usage is in line with responsible use patterns for similar farms in that region of the EU and intervene if necessary
