CanScreen-ECIS – Strengthening cancer screening data collection to update the European Cancer Information System and improve quality and coverage of cancer screening programmes in Europe



CanScreen-ECIS will contribute to Europe's Beating Cancer Plan by creating a platform for monitoring the performance of cancer screening programmes in Europe, providing valuable data for professionals, policymakers and the public.

The CanScreen-ECIS project aims to **develop a system for collecting, managing, and disseminating performance data from cancer screening programmes in European countries**, with the ultimate goal of enabling screening programmes to continually evaluate and improve their performance.

The European Cancer Information System (ECIS) is a tool for reporting on **cancer incidence, mortality, and survival rates**, developed by the European Commission.

The project will refine performance indicators for:	Develop new indicators for:
 Breast	 Lung cancer screening
 Cervical	
 Colorectal cancer screening	

These indicators will allow for **comparison of screening programmes, monitoring of inequalities**, and the **proposal of additional indicators** to cover new screening approaches and cancer sites.

A data warehouse and web application will be created for providers of screening data to access the tools and submit data.

User friendliness of data: the web application will analyse data and display it with interactive graphs, tables, and charts.

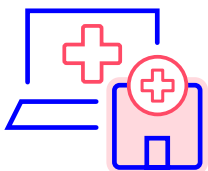
CanScreen-ECIS will:

- Facilitate systematic and ongoing evaluation based on harmonised and comparable indicators;



- Enable programme managers to work with stakeholders to improve the quality and coverage of cancer screening services in Europe.
