Council Conclusions on innovation for the benefit of patients (2014)

The Council invites Member States and the Commission:

- to further enhance joint work on HTA

The Council invites the Commission:

- to support the cooperation between Member States to implement the HTA strategy through a **Joint Action** while **exploring options for continued and sustainable financing**







HTA – post 2020

1) Strategy for EU cooperation on HTA

The HTA Network calls upon the Commission to explore:

- How to secure support for activities necessary to facilitate joint work at EU level on a permanent basis and
- How a range of models, including existing structures, could **facilitate cooperation between HTA Bodies and create efficiency gains, scientific synergies** as well as safeguard the scientific independence of the process.

2) Council Conclusions on innovation for the benefit of patients (2014)

The Council invites the Commission:

- To propose measures **to ensure the long-term sustainability of HTA work on HTA**, fully exploring all potential options, including considerations on how to make the best use of existing bodies which could facilitate the cooperation, efficiency gains and scientific synergies.





Commission Work Programme 2016:

"The preparatory work will be launched and will enhance consultation on HTA to improve the functioning of the single market for health products".
