It was noted that the procedures followed by the WG are in accord with the SCHEER procedures and principles, that the SCHEER opinions are open for public consultation and that any comments received are considered and responded to by the SCHEER. No further action was considered necessary
- The Chair discussed a possible SCHEER contribution to the DG ENV public consultation on <u>Integrated water management – revised lists of surface and groundwater pollutants</u> (europa.eu) (DL 14 March)
- The mandating DG has been informed that the WG will be closed after March meetings should no new mandate be received.
