Minutes

1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interests

2. List of points discussed

2.1. New mandates

Mandate for an opinion on three coatings for Zinc oxide (nano form) [Methicone (CAS/EC 9004-73-3/ 236-675-5), Silica (CAS/EC 7631-869/231-545-4) and Isostearic acid (CAS/EC 30399-84-9/250178-0)] as UV-filter in dermally applied cosmetic products. Mandate was adopted by written procedure and published. A Rapporteur was selected and appointed.

2.2. Legislative points from GROW

• ASASP sent a letter to DG GROW regarding the SCCS Opinion on the Solubility of Synthetic Amorphous Silica. The SCCS WG on nanomaterials prepared a reply covering scientific questions raised by the Applicant. Reply was sent to

GROW so that a reply to the Applicant can be prepared by GROW legal colleagues.

- Update of the SCCS nano guidance. Discussion took place on contributions and distribution of new tasks. The document will be discussed at the next meeting and ready for adoption at the October plenary meeting.
