GD no. 617/2014 is specified that the Ministry of Health (MH) is assigned as competent authority for coordination of national-le vel measures required for enforcement of the BPR. Also, in this national regulations mentions the following entities are assigned as authorities responsible for performance of official controls on compliance with BPR's requirements as per provisions of art 65 para. (2) in BPR. as shown below:

- a) Ministry of Health through public health directions;
- b) Ministry of Environment and Climate Change through the National Environmental Guard;
- c) National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority through its regional / Bucharest sanitary-veterinary and food safet y directions.

Attributions of personnel assigned to perform official controls are approved, as per legal conditions, by Order no. 726/2015. In accordance with this regulations, the assigned representatives (individuals assigned by the public authorities set in GD no. 61 7/2014) shall perform official controls based on competences on manufacturers, importers, distributors and professional / industrial end users as follows:

- a) Ministry of Health (MH) through public health directorates: PT1, PT2, PT5, PT4 as per competences set forth in relevant regulations, PT5, PT14, PT18, PT19, PT22.
- b) Ministry of Environment and Climate Change through the National Environmental Guard (NEG): PT6-PT13, PT15, PT16, PT17, PT 21;
- c) National Sanitary Veterinary and Food Safety Authority (NSVFSA) through its regional / Bucharest sanitary-veterinary and food safety directions: PT3, PT4 as per competences set forth in relevant regulations.

The Order no. 726/2015 established that official control means any form of control performed by assigned representatives to provi de checks on compliance of biocidal products with relevant legislation. Also, the terms "inspection" represents activity performe d within official controls, by assigned representatives, in any type of units in private and public sectors (manufacturers, impor ters, distributors, professional / industrial end users), consisting in a certified verification of compliance with legal regulat is on biocidal products and of consistent application thereof, respectively the official audit of all documents, labels and packaging of biocidal products, of biocidal product records, of applicable standards, of specifications of active substances and ing redients used in manufacture of the biocidal products, of material safety data sheets, of results of internal quality controls and of any other element with relevance for marketing and use of biocidal products, including publicity.

The official control may include investigation of biocidal product, including collection of samples during targeted control actio n and, in case of suspicions, to assess the respective product in an accredited laboratory to certify that the biocidal product is compliant with legal provisions and requirements set forth in the administrative document for marketing of biocidal products or in the assessment report, as the case may be. If the biocidal product is noncompliant, costs incurred by analysis of biocidal product sample are charged to the manufacturer / importer / distributor, as the case may be.

The assigned representatives have access to all locations, documents and information related to marketed and used biocidal products, based on their respective competences.

The assigned representatives assert violation of the facts specified in GD no. 617/2014 and applies the sanctions established in this national normative act.

The assigned representatives perform official controls based on:

- a) annual official control plans, with predetermined targets;
- b) claims and complaints, when issues claimed require such control;
- c) requests from other authorities.

For the official controls, in addition to the national normative acts, each competent authority uses specific procedures, methodo logies and guidelines according to the competencies.

In Romania there is no strategy regarding the control of implementation the BPR, but according to Order no. 726/2015, MH, NEG and NSVFSA prepares annual official control plans and notifies the same to the Ministry of Health until December 15th of each year. MH elaborates, each year, the national market surveillance plan for biocidal products market, as per provisions in Regulation (E C) no. 765/2008 setting out the requirements for accreditation and market surveillance relating to the marketing ofproducts and repealing Regulation (EEC) No 339/93.

The plan for the following year and the result of the official control activity carried out in the previous year are sent in Janu ary by MH for all three authorities to the Ministry of Economy (competent authority for market surveillance in Romania) which sen ds it to the European Commission.
