

The group agreed on:



The mission of the EHII is to improve the information that underpins health policy through fostering international cooperation in order to exchange expertise, build capacity and harmonize data collection.




EHII operational framework


Action plan, including e.g.:

- •Regular reporting to SG on cooperation WHO, EC and OECD in health information / indicator development



- First ever public health journal published by WHO Regional Office for Europe!
- Bilingual journal entire content in English and Russian - aiming to bridge the research and dissemination gap between the Eastern and Western part of the European Region.
- Publishing country-specific and regional good practices and case studies.



PUBLIC HEALTH PANORAMA

- Issue 2 will be a special themed issue addressing the importance for public health of intersectoral action, highlighting lessons and experiences from the long legacy of such action in the WHO European Region.

Health information strategies

Support tool

to assess health information systems and develop and strengthen health information strategies



- SCRC requested practical support tool
- Tool developed by Working Group (17 MS), co-chaired by Netherlands and Russian Federation
- Based on WHO HMN tools and materials, European context added
- (Nearly) available in English & Russian
- Next steps; implement the tool in Member States and improve/supplement the tool based on experiences





EHII: next steps

- Strengthen the evidence base on health and migration through HEN synthesis reports;
- Support the development of an accelerated roadmap to strengthen evidence-informed policy-making;
- Recommendations for the WHO expert group on the cultural contexts of health and well-being;
- Recommendations to strengthen and modernize national health research systems in some parts of the Region.
