Data on patient mobility in 2018



Background

- In order to assess the impact of the Directive, a questionnaire has been sent to all MS since 2016 to collect information on patient movement in each preceding year.
- Data collection covered four broad areas:
 - 1. Requests for Information
 - 2. Requests for Prior Authorisation & reasons for grant or refusal of authorisation
 - 3. Reimbursement for treatments with Prior Authorisation (PA)
 - 4. Requests for reimbursement for treatments without Prior Authorisation (PA)
- The data presented do not include reports on cross-border care provided under legal instruments other than the Directive, such as the Social Security Regulation (883/2004) or bi-lateral and other parallel agreements.



Data Quality

2018 Data Quality


- The quality of data has improved significantly over the three years of data collection.
- We received responses on 2018 mobility from 27 countries (BG, CY, and IS were not able to reply).
- Data from some countries was limited: DE, NL and SE were not able to provide mobility data, but did return the form with basic information.
- BE was not able to complete all sections due to the way in which data are collected in country.

2015-2018 data quality

- Reporting has generally improved since 2015, although challenges remain for some countries in distinguishing between mobility under the Directive an mobility under the regulation.
- Some countries also struggle with national level data aggregation.

• Most countries reported requests fewer than 4,000 requests for information.

• Latvia: 62, 591 requests


Estonia: 27,242 requests

Requests for information 2017-2018




- Latvia: 62, 591 requests for information in 2018, up from 275 in 2017
- Estonia: 27,242 requests for information in 2018, up from 2,243 in 2017

Total number of requests for PA: 7,266 across 21 MA




Requests Authorised – 5,215

Trends

- 7,266 requests received, up from 5,902 requests received in 2017.
- 10 MS reported fewer than 100 requests.


Outcomes of Prior Authorisation Requests in 2018

Grounds for Authorisation




Authorised Requests – Overnight Stay – 2,364

PA system implemented

- 21 MS implemented PA
- EE, FI, LT, NL and NO did not

Total Requests:

 7,266 requests received, most MS fewer than 100


Outliers:

- FR: 3,0769 of which 2067 authorised
- IE: 1,854 requests of which 1296 authorised
- UK: 978 requests of which
 321 authorised
- LU with 427 of which 773 authorised
- SK: 302 requests of which 280 authorised

All other MS reported fewer than 20 authorisations



Patient Mobility with Prior Authorisation 2017-2018



Trends


 The average number of reimbursements made across the Member States was low

Total Requests:


• **271,549** requests received, most MS fewer than 100

- PL: 18,666 requests of which15,751 authorised




Patient Mobility not requiring Prior Authorisation 2017-2018
