EU aid to the health sector 2014-2020

provisional figures

- bilateral/geographic funding (EDF, DCI, ENI)
- thematic funding (GPGC, CSO-LA / DCI)
- other sources of funding (intra-ACP / EDF, PanAfrican / DCI)



Bilateral/geographic funding (provisional)

- As of today, total provisional amount for bilateral funding is EUR 1,440 est. million in 19 countries
- NIP/MIPs signed in 14 countries (EUR 1,569*M)

GPGC (DCI)	€ 4,917 M	At least 40% of GPGC/Human Development
Intra-ACP (EDF)	€ 3,590 M	Programming on-going with ACP Secretariat
CSO-LA (DCI)	€ 1,800 M	indicative 70-75% of the funds allocated at country level through EUDs in relation to partner countries' requests
PanAfrican (DCI)	€ 845 M	Programming ongoing



GPGC - financial allocations 2014-2020 (indicative)

- Environment and climate change 27%
- Sustainable energy 12%
- Human development 25%
 of which at least 40% for health
- Food and nutrition security and sustainable agriculture 29%
- Migration and asylum 7%



GPGC objectives in health

- OB 1: communicable diseases control
- OB 2: building of capacity and translation of knowledge into practice
- OB 3: improve access to essential health commodities and sexual and reproductive health services




Global health initiatives

- GFATM and GAVI are funded from GPGC (DCI) and Intra-ACP (EDF)
- Current pledge for GFATM: average EUR 150M per year during 2014-2016
- Current pledge for GAVI: EUR 200M during 2016-2020




Bilateral aid Profiles of countries (19)






Bilateral aid Profiles of countries (19)

majority of **fragile** countries




majority of LICs
