

## **EUDAMED** European database on medical devices


The notified body (NB) shall enter EUDAMED any information regarding certificates issued, including amendments and supplements thereto, and regarding suspended, reinstated, withdrawn or refused certificates and restrictions imposed on certificates.

Such information shall be accessible to the public.

## CERTIFICATE UNIQUE IDENTIFIER How is a certificate identified?

### CERTIFICATE PAPER VERSION UNIQUE IDENTIFIER

The paper Certificate version is identified by a unique number which is the "NB number + Certificate number (+ possibly 'Revision number')".




Current Actor in EUDAMED (Notified Body Identification number from Nando is automatically identified from user acting on behalf of NB.)

**EUDAMED CERTIFICATE DATA VERSION IDENTIFICATION** 

The EUDAMED Certificate data version is identified by the "Certificate paper version unique identifier" and the "EUDAMED version number".






incremented for any update of a certificate like for the certificate paper version identifier. However, in case of decision (Withdrawn, Suspended, Re-instated ...) applied on a certificate, it will mean a new EUDAMED version although not a new Certificate paper version.

# Status of Certificate and Certificate version identifier

STATUS OF CERTIFICATE



### the certificate number can be kept as it is for the preceding certificate only if a new Revision number is provided.

(A) **CERTIFICATE** 

#### The **uniqueness of the certificate** identifier must be guarantee either only with a "Certificate number" or with both a "Certificate number" and "Revision number".




# **EUDAMED CERTIFICATE VERSION** Versioning of the certificate data in EUDAMED

EUDAMED will keep track of the historical data provided for the certificate registration/updates and decisions on the status of certificates.

Therefore, EUDAMED will always create its own version

of the certificate data (incremental from 1 to n).





For each EUDAMED certificate version, several information will be **stored** among which the version number and the submission date.
