Specific provisions for the Health strand

Operational objectives- Article 26



Improving **crisis preparedness and response** against cross-border health threats



Strengthening **health systems** (digital transformation, EU health information, support to national reforms)



Supporting **EU health legislation** (*medicines, HTA, tobacco, cross-border care*)



Supporting **integrated work** (*European Reference Networks, best practices for health promotion and disease prevention*)





Health strand – geographical scope Article 28

- EU Member States
- Associate countries or third countries (in accordance with specific agreements):
 - EEA members
 - Acceding countries, candidate countries and potential candidates
 - Other third countries
 - Neighborhood countries
- International organizations





Health strand – implementation Article 29

Commission assisted by Health Authorities of Member States

- Main interlocutor: Steering Group for Health Promotion and Disease Prevention
- Upstream and more interactive/productive consultations compared to current arrangements





Multinannual Planning of Health Strand

- Start of multinannual planning while negotiations still ongoing
- Main features and envisaged structure of draft multinannual planning document:
 - Description of activities to be implemented under each objective and sub-objective of health Strand
 - Aim, Expected Impact and
 - Possible synergies and complementarities with other EU Programmes and Funds (eg. HE, other strands of ESF+, ERDF, Digital Europe, InvestEU Fund, DG REFORM/SRSS...
- Draft multiannual planning document to be sent to SGPP Members, for comments, after the meeting of 23/1/2020
