5th webinar organized on 7 May by the "COVID-19 Clinical Management Support System" on "COVID-19 in patients with cardiomyopathies and myocarditis"

Three experts will hold the seminar, which will take place on **7 May from 17.00 to 18.00** (CET). The purpose of the webinar is to provide clinicians with the most updated knowledge on patients with rare diseases of the cardiovascular system, particularly cardiomyopathies and myocarditis. It will give insights on how to find information and who to ask for help if a patient affected by cardiomyopathies and myocarditis has also contracted the COVID-19. The experts are linked to the ERN GUARD HEART which is the European Reference Network on rare diseases of the heart.

The webinar will be held by **Prof. Philippe Charron**, Head of National Referral Center for cardiac hereditary or rare diseases, Pitié-Salpêtrière hospital & Sorbonne University, Paris in France, by **Prof. Perry Elliott**, from the Centre for Heart Muscle Disease, University College London and St. Bartholomew's Hospital, London, UK and by **Prof. Alida LP Caforio**, MD, PhD, FES, R. Cardiology, Department of Cardiac Thoracic Vascular Sciences and Public Health, University of Padova- Azienda Ospedaliera di Padova in Italy.

Attendees will then be able to ask questions to the speakers. The webinar will be recorded and available for off line vision afterwards.

In the context of the "COVID-19 Clinical Management Support System" launched by the European Commission, DG SANTE organises a series of webinars to support clinicians and other healthcare professionals at the frontline of the care of COVID-19 patients. These webinars will bring the expertise and recommendations of several experts from the 24 ERNs in the management of challenging cases of patients suffering at the same time of COVID-19 and a rare or complex disease or conditions.


