An OECD Project to Assess the Economics of Alcohol Consumption (and Other Risk Factors)

- **Objective:** to develop a framework to assess the economics of alcohol
 - Alcohol's impact on the economy
 - The impact on the economic of tackling Alcohol
- **Geographical scope:** primary focus on EU and OECD countries but potential to be extended more broadly
- **Timeframe:** 2 year project started in January 2017

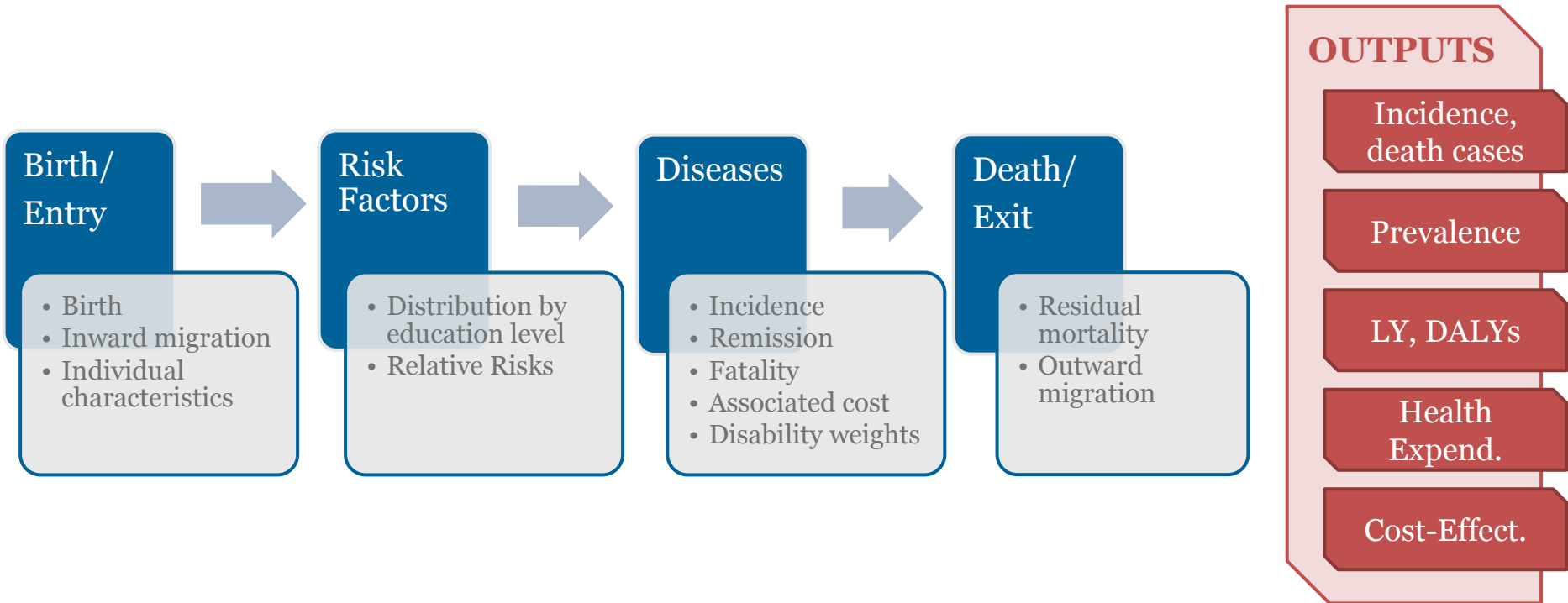
