#### **8. MANDATE FOR A GUIDANCE DOCUMENT FOR THE SAFETY ASSESSMENT DOSSIERS OF NANOMATERIALS**

The WG has received a mandate from the EC for the preparation of a Guidance Document for the safety assessment dossiers of nanomaterial. This mandate was presented to the members of the WG.

#### **9. MEETING WITH INDUSTRY**

Representatives from the industry consortium which submitted the present dossiers on TiO<sub>2</sub> and ZnO were invited by the WG in order to discuss some open questions regarding the ZnO dossier and the safety assessment of nanomaterial in cosmetics in general.
