# Meeting of the Working Group on Cosmetic Ingredients in Cosmetic Products

21-22 January 2025, Luxembourg

## **Minutes**

## 1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interest

The Chair welcomed the participants.

## 2. List of points discussed

## 2.1. Draft Opinions

The WG discussed preliminary opinions on:

- Melaleuca Alternifolia (Tea Tree) Leaf Oil CMR exemption
- Diethylamino Hydroxybenzoyl Hexyl Benzoate DHHB
- Butylated Hydroxyanisole BHA
- Benzophenone-2 and 5
- Prostaglandin and analogues

Tasks were allocated among members and these preliminary texts will be further discussed in the next WG meeting.

The following preliminary opinions were adopted by written procedure and have been published in January 2025 for commenting period:

- Scientific advice on Methyl Salicylate children exposure -> by 17 February
- Salicylic acid children exposure -> by 10 March
- Butylparaben children exposure -> by 10 March
