- **Prior authorisation for planned treatment;**
- **Administrative obstacles;**
- **Overcharging of incoming patients;**
- **Information to patients**

Cross-Border Healthcare Expert Group – 17 Nov 2020

- Discussion on exchanges of Good Practice to support MS implementation of CBHC Directive. Conclusions:
 - Sufficient interest among Member States to share experience & best practice.
 - A possible format could be a 1 ½-day workshop to be hosted in a MS.

Action to support better implementation of CBHC Directive - 2020-2021

- Exchange good practices on implementation problems through 3 **dedicated workshops**, including 1 with NCPs
- 3 **analytical reports** – mapping of prior authorisation in EU-27.
- **improve data on cross-border patient mobility** in healthcare: case studies to collect data in border regions & design of indicators to assess Directive's impact in 2022-2023.
