

**EC:** Review Tool (Annex 2 – Draft) and consultation other services

(DG SANTE, DG ENV and ECDC);

EC: Preparatory work for the AMR team (collect information);

MS: Verification of the preliminary list of NAPs for review;

**MS:** Indication of a national contact point(s).




