Orphanet: introduction

- The online European knowledge platform and database for rare diseases and orphan drugs....
 - Nomenclature (Orphacodes)
 - Data and knowledge: for policy, practice and research
- Funding: France, EU, Member States
 - EU funding since 2000 for various & subsequent activities
 - 2018 direct grant: to contribute to consolidation of Orphanet as <u>the</u> European reference source of information on rare diseases.
- EU Financial Regulation: no structural funding!



SGPP process until now

- Aims to identify realistic options for a more sustainable future for Orphanet, also identifying Member States which could be interested in providing contribution to its core functions.
- Nov 2018:
 - Concept paper by INSERM /France
 - Survey initial exchange of thought on 3 questions
- Until 22 Jan: Member States respond to eSurvey
- 14 Feb: SGPP reflection



Key outcomes eSurvey

- Detailed responses from 14 Member States
- Vast majority of which expressed:
 - Overall appreciation of Orphanet
 - Continued support for national activities already undertaken
- Several Member States: principal readiness to contribute to the core functions, either in kind and/or through a financial contribution.



Financial contribution (Q1)?



'A direct financial contribution against services provided by Orphanet could be considered as we indeed make use of several costly services of Orphanet that are impossible to achieve at national level'

Administrative rules / fin. resources bottleneck



Non-financial contribution (Q2)?


- Yes:
 - national experts' time (ten Member States) and
 - sharing IT infrastructure (Fr)
 - Hosting meetings (Be)
- More clarity about future organisation/structure may open up more possibilities

Support in other ways (Q3)?

- Ongoing and/or planned national activities
- Participation EU-funded projects (incl. research);
 board or management activities; IT services.

- Step by step, tailored approach
- Orphanet to develop draft Framework Agreement
 - Allowing for diversity
- Developing proposal on next steps by June 2019 for SGPP to be consulted again
