



# Scientific Committee on Consumer Safety (SCCS) Meeting of the Working Group on Cosmetic Ingredients in Cosmetic Products

15-16 May, Luxembourg

#### **Minutes**

## 1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interests

The Chair welcomed the participants, including DG GROW.

This was a hybrid meeting. One apology was received for both days. Five apologies were received for one day only and one for half a day.

#### 2.1 New mandates or information from DG GROW

No new mandate was adopted.

#### 2.2 Draft opinions discussed

The following dossiers have been discussed:

- Silver zinc zeolite: the preliminary Opinion is under commenting period until 5 June: see SCCS Opinions (europa.eu)
- TiO2 scientific advice in oral and inhalation cosmetic products: the Applicant has submitted information. The SCCS is considering it.
- Methylparaben: the preliminary Opinion is planned to be adopted in plenary meeting.
- Butylparaben: the preliminary Opinion is planned to be adopted in plenary meeting.
- Methylsalicylate scientific advice published with exceptional commenting period until 19 June: see SCCS Scientific Advice children exposure on Methyl salicylate
- Benzyl salicylate: the preliminary Opinion is planned to be adopted in plenary meeting.
- Hexylsalicylate: CMR2 exemption –>the draft preliminary opinion will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Hair dye HC blue 18 (submission II analytical file) -> the scientific advice has been published in the final version: see SCCS Opinions (europa.eu)
- Zn salts in oral products (submission II) -> the preliminary Opinion is planned to be adopted in plenary meeting

### 2.3 Comments on opinions

• Salicylic acid: the Applicant submitted the expected information. The final Opinion is planned to be adopted in plenary meeting

#### 3. Information from Chairman/Members/Commission

• ECHA Workshop on New approach methodologies: "*Towards an animal free regulatory system for industrial chemicals*" on 31 May – 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023 -> SCCS Chair and vice-Chair are planning to participate.

- ECHA-RAC/SCCS symposium on New Approach Methodologies is planned on 7 June (a.m.) during SCCS plenary meeting co-organised with ECHA. The SCCS Chair and vice-Chairs will present the SCCS position.
- <u>Cosmetics Europe annual event on 14 June</u>: Secretariat is planning to present the SCCS update of dossiers and SCCS vice-Chair to present changes in the published 12<sup>th</sup> revision of the SCCS Notes of Guidance.
- The Commission published an open call for expression of interest to become an observer in the Drug Precursors expert group: Register of Commission expert groups and other similar entities
- The <u>IDEA</u> project is planning to organise a second RCPL Workshop on 22 September 2023 in Brussels, as a hybrid event. SCCS vice-Chairs are planning to represent the SCCS as observers.
- EFSA has decided to extend the deadline of the open call OC/EFSA/KNOW/2023/01 for the Provision of Specialised Training Courses on Specific Aspects of Chemical Risk Assessment and Related Tools from 26/04/2023 to 25/05/2023. The call extension is published in e-Tendering (link <a href="here">here</a>) as well as the call in subject is publicised on the <a href="here">EFSA website</a>, including links to all procurement documents.
