- The overall objective of the Ministerial Conference was to accelerate political commitment and generate contributions to the realization of the WHO Global Action Plan on AMR.
- raising awareness for the threat of AMR and developing initiatives on how to address this threat
- Clear focus One Health Approach

- G20 leaders declaration contains call for action on AMR R&D, july 2017
- EU One Health Action Plan against AMR, 2017
- EU Joint Action AMR (JAMRAI) 2017-2020
- Council Conclusions 2016 (Dutch presidency), 2019 (Romanian presidency)





- In cooperation with WHO, FAO, IOE
- The *aim* of the conference: to strengthen and accelerate international cooperation in the global fight against antimicrobial resistance.
- The *focus* of the conference: international and multi-sectoral cooperation within the framework of the One Health approach.
