

- Published on 4 September 2015
- Sets out the current state of play of transposition
- Covers the most important and relevant provisions e.g.
 - ✓ use of prior authorisation
 - ✓ level of patient mobility
 - ✓ reimbursement practices
 - ✓ information to patients
 - ✓ cooperation under the Directive

- Discussed at the Informal Health Ministerial meeting in Luxemburg on 24/25 September 2015
- ➤ Debated with the EP Environment, Public Health and Food Safety Committee on 23 February 2016
- Presented at the Committee of the Regions on 29 February 2016
