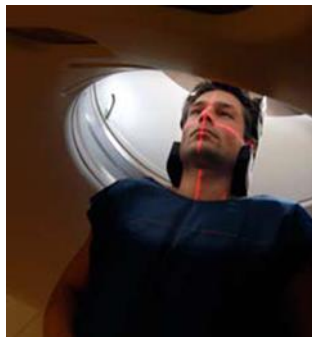

- Sets out the current state of play of transposition
- Covers the most important and relevant provisions *e.g.*
 - ✓ use of prior authorisation
 - ✓ level of patient mobility
 - ✓ reimbursement practices
 - ✓ information to patients
 - ✓ cooperation under the Directive

- Debated with the EP Environment, Public Health and Food Safety Committee on 23 February 2016
