EU4Health – State of play

24 March
2021

- Adoption of the EU4Health Programme Regulation (EU) 2021/522

24 June
2021

- Adoption of the **Work Programme 2021** (EUR 312 million maximum Union contribution)
- Four strands of action: crisis preparedness, disease prevention, health systems and the healthcare workforce, and digitalization, with cancer as a crosscutting priority.
- Implementation: ongoing

End 2021

- Preparatory work to identify strategic orientations and priorities for Work Programme 2022
- Targeted stakeholders' consultation
- Consultation of Member States through the EU4Health Steering Group
- Possible adoption of the **Work Programme 2022**

EU4Health 2022 Work Programme – EU4Health Steering Group

- Member States consulted on **strategic orientations and priorities**
- Meetings held on 14 July and 20 September 2021
- Wide range of **possible priorities** to strengthen efforts on health promotion and disease prevention, such as:
 - ✓ supporting the prevention of mental health issues
 - ✓ addressing the common risk factors for non-communicable diseases
 - ✓ increasing health literacy and health awareness

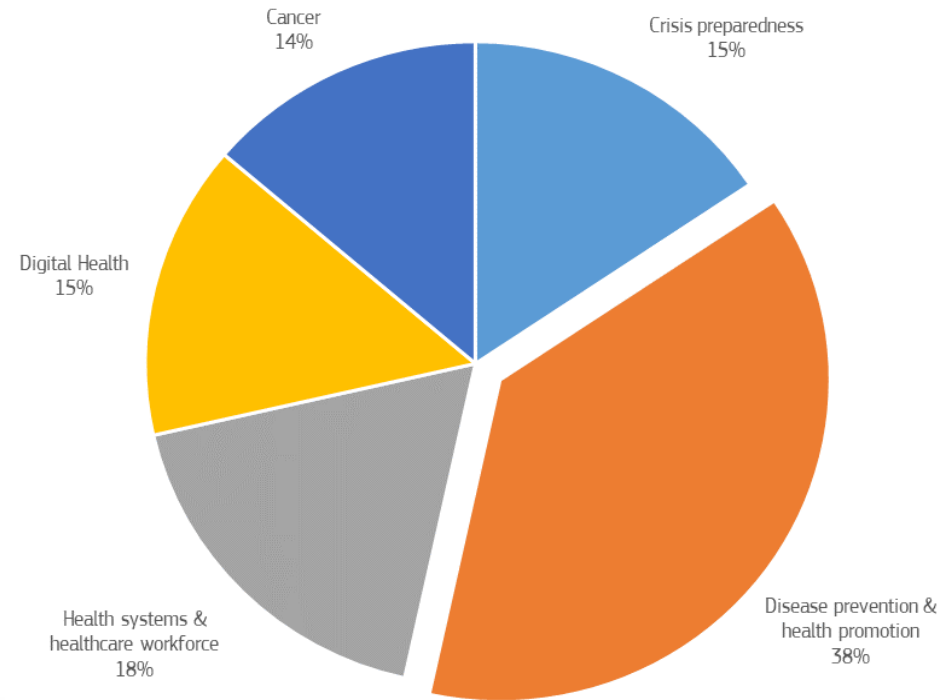
EU4Health 2022 Work Programme – targeted
