- Draft mandate on Gold/colloidal gold and surface modified gold.

2.2. Legislative points from GROW

- Next mandate to be sent to SCCS via the CPNP portal –platinum
- DG GROW will perform Call for data and Literature search will be done via the EC Library for platinum, gold and copper

2.3. Draft opinions discussed

- Two coatings for Titanium Dioxide (nano form) (Methicone CAS/EC 9004-73-3/236-675-5 and Perfluorooctyl Triethoxy silane CAS/EC 51851-37-7/257-473-3) as UV-filter in dermally applied cosmetic products
 - SCCS sent a third request to the Applicant.
- Update of the SCCS nano guidance discussion on contributions and distribution of new tasks. The group is planning to finalise the guidance for June plenary meeting. The nano Checklist for Applicants is under revision too.

2.4. Comments on Opinions

• Opinion on the Solubility of Synthetic Amorphous Silica (SAS) was adopted at the February plenary meeting and published for commenting period until 17 May 2019. One comment has been received so far.
