#### 4. *IN VITRO* MUTAGENICITY TESTING WITH THE PRACTICAL EXAMPLE OF DIHYDROXY ACETONE

Having encountered the first concrete examples where the genotoxic potential of a substance could not be excluded as at least one of the *in vitro* tests was positive and no follow-up testing *in vivo* could be done, the SCCS decided to dedicate a special discussion on this issue to:

- 1) receive input on a concrete case example (DHA), and
- 2) discuss in general how *in vitro* genotoxicity testing could be improved to avoid an excess of false positive results

#### 5. COMMENTS ON ECVAM REPORT OF ALTERNATIVE METHODS

The WG discussed the ECVAM report and comments on the document were collected. The Secretariat will circulate a consolidated document for final approval.
