on behalf of the AKDA, the German Association of Hospital Pharmacists, a German national professional organization, we would like to contribute a short comment on the Consultation document mentioned above.

It seems as if the last paragraph in section 3.1, lines 102-109, is not quite complete? Assuming that medicinal products prepared in a pharmacy as magistral formula or in accordance with a prescription for an individual patient are allowed to be used as AMPs without further justification, we would recommend that these may be prepared without full GMP but according to standard pharmacy practice, as suggested in section 3.2.
