## Health Programme Financial support and results

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# Activities of ERNs co-funded under the health programme

#### Financing decision (Annual Work programme 2016):

"Coordination, management and non-clinical activities of an approved ERN in support of ERN goals "





## **Coordinators can request support** for

- (i) networking and coordination activities;
- (ii) administrative and logistic support
- (iii) development of knowledge generation tools(clinical guidelines, patient pathways);
- (iv) training and eLearning activities; and
- (v) meetings of the network members and participation in conferences or events related to the network's area of expertise;





# **Providing a better governance and coordination so that ERNs can:**

- (i) offer the possibility to work in multidisciplinary teams across different EU countries;
- (ii) increase the level of expertise;
- (iii) build capacity to produce good practice guidelines, to implement outcome measures and quality control;
- (iv) provide support to research coordination and teaching and training activities;





# Main funding scheme 24 ERNs

#### **Mono-beneficiary grants:**

Awarded to the ERN Coordinator

**Duration:** 23 ERNs: 1/03/2017-28/02/2022 5-years Framework Partnership Agreement (FPA); 3 Specific Grant Agreements (SGAs) covering: 1<sup>st</sup> year , 2<sup>nd</sup> year; 3-5<sup>th</sup> year

1 ERN: 3 year 1/06/2018-31/5/2021

**Funding amount:** Up to EUR 200 000 per network and per year Total EUR 23 600 000





# **Other funding**

#### **Project grants for registries:** Call in 2016 5 projects funded for EUR 1 979 361

#### Procurement

Clinical decision support tools: taxonomy and templates for deliverables, including training EUR 400 000

Development of clinical guidelines EUR 4 million Networking, communication and coordination between networks (several service contracts)





# Achievements 18 months on

### **Internal Coordination:**

All ERNs have established their **governance models** and **Quality Assurance Plans** or other **Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs)** for their working procedures

#### **Dissemination:**

All ERNs have established specific **dissemination** and communication plans and websites

#### **Evaluation:**

All ERNs have established internal **evaluation activities** 





# Achievements 18 months on

## **Clinical management tools**

All ERNs have established or further developed their own **databases and/or registries** 

### **Clinical Guidelines**

Most ERNs have developed **clinical guidelines** in their field of activity

**Clinical Patient Management System (CPMS<sup>\*</sup>)** All ERNs are using or are preparing to use the IT Platform for clinical consultations between ERN Members \* *funded through the Connecting Europe Facility (CEF)* 



## **Achievements 18 months on**

### **Scientific and clinical cooperation** Setup of working groups bringing together leading European centres:

Education, Clinical Guidelines and recommendations, Registries and Bio banks, IT and e-Health, Molecular Testing, Patient Organisations and on Communication Stem Cell and Gene Therapy, Transition Care, Pharmaco-vigilance and Biological Therapies







Translating financial and technical support into sustainable operations

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# **Optimize the initial funding rounds to achieve sustainable operations**

## **Technical sustainability**

Moving from best practice sharing and showcasing to **standardization** (sharing of experience and capacity building)

Moving from ad-hoc assessment (currently undertaken by the Independent Assessment Bodies) to an **internal system of quality improvement** 





# **Optimize the initial funding round to achieve sustainable operations**

## **Financial sustainability**

Additional funding for the implementation and following phases is to be included under the new MFF;

Support sustainability also requires:

- The whole network takes ownership & activities are integrated into HCP general operational framework and into national health systems
- Using the health programme to access other (multiple, bigger and more appropriate funding sources)
