



# Scientific Committee on Consumer Safety (SCCS) Meeting of the Working Group on Cosmetic Ingredients in Cosmetic Products

20-21 June, Luxembourg

#### **Minutes**

# 1. Welcome and apologies, approval of the agenda and declaration of interests

The Chair welcomed the participants. DG GROW was excused.

This was a hybrid meeting. Two apologies were received for one day. One for half a day.

The agenda was adopted without changes.

## 2. List of points discussed

### 2.1 New mandates or information from DG GROW

No new mandate was adopted.

A request for clarification for a potential submission was discussed among the WG and a draft response agreed on.

### 2.2 Draft opinions discussed

The following dossiers have been discussed:

- Zn salts in oral products (submission II) -> the preliminary Opinion was finalised and it will be adopted by written procedure before publication for commenting period.
- TiO2 scientific advice in oral and inhalation cosmetic products: the SCCS sent a request for clarification to the Applicant with a deadline by the end of June. The draft preliminary Opinion was discussed, and tasks were allocated to members. It will be further discussed in the next meeting.
- Triphenylphosphate (TPP): the draft preliminary Opinion was presented and it will be further discussed in the next meeting.
- Hexylsalicylate: CMR2 exemption: the draft preliminary Opinion was discussed, and tasks were allocated to the members. It will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Acetylated vetiver oil (AVO) Subm. IV acute inhalation: the rapporteur made a
  presentation on the dossier submitted and the way forward was discussed by the WG.
- Benzophenone -1: the draft preliminary Opinion was presented, and tasks were allocated to the members. It will be further discussed in the next meeting.
- Benzophenone 4: it will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Aluminium 2023 updated use concentration: it will be discussed in the next meeting.

### 2.3 Comments on opinions

- Methylsalicylate scientific advice published with exceptional commenting period until 19 June. One comment was received. It will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Silver zinc zeolite: the preliminary Opinion was under commenting period until 5 June and received comments. It will be discussed in the next meeting.
- Methylparaben: the preliminary Opinion is open for comment until 21 August.
- Butylparaben: the preliminary Opinion is open for comment until 21 August.
- Benzyl salicylate: the preliminary Opinion is open for comment until 24 August.

- ECHA Workshop on New approach methodologies: "*Towards an animal free regulatory system for industrial chemicals*" on 31 May 1<sup>st</sup> June 2023 -> SCCS vice-Chair participated and reported. Presentations were made available to the WG for information.
- Helsinki plenary: SCCS Chair reported to the WG and SCCS presentation during the ECHA-Risk Assessment Committee/SCCS symposium on New Approach Methodologies on 7 June was made available to the WG for information, as well as RAC presentations.
- <u>Cosmetics Europe annual event on 14 June</u>: Secretariat presented the SCCS update
  of ongoing mandates and SCCS vice-Chair presented changes in the published 12<sup>th</sup>
  revision of the SCCS Notes of Guidance.
- SCCS Chair reported on <u>Inter-committee coordination group (2022-2026)</u> (europa.eu) meeting (ICCG) held on 15 June. One member of the SCCS will join the SCHEER WG on weight of evidence (self-task).
- DG Environment is organising the Fifth Annual Forum on Endocrine Disruptors on 19 (full day) and 20 October 2023 (morning only). The SCCS is planning to be represented by the vice-Chair.
