
#### 2.1.2. Drunkenness among 15-year-olds, 2009-10


# 2.6.1. Alcohol consumption among population aged 15 years and over, 2010 OECD



 Prevent alcohol related harm among adults and reduce impact on workplace




Inform, educate and raise awareness




# Consumer information on alcohol packages

#### **Eurobarometer 331/2010**

79% respondents agree with the idea to put warnings on alcohol bottles related to pregnancy and drink driving

- Broader range of risks to address
- Enhancing visibility aspects
- Broader communication campaigns to reinforce the messages
- Monitoring of implementation and impact







# Actions: consumer information on alcohol packages



#### France:

- warning about pregnancy-related risks mandatory since 2007
- United Kingdom: agreement between government and industry in 2007
  - alcohol content in "units"
  - Chief Medical Officers' drinking guidelines
  - warning on risks related to pregnancy











# Actions: consumer information on alcohol packages













**Pernot-Ricard** pregnancy warning on all products in France

**SabMiller** 3 alternative messages on all products: drink-driving, pregnancy, minimum age

**ABInBev** 'no drinking during pregnancy' and 'don't drink and drive' on the back-labels of all products produced in Europe





# Other actions by stakeholders

#### **European Midwives Association**

- alcohol-related education in midwifery education: survey of content and practices (2008-2010)
- raising awareness of harmful alcohol consumption during pregnancy (2012-2014)

#### **EUROCARE**

• **awareness-raising**: conferences, workshops, factsheets, website, labelling initiative (2008-2010)

#### **Brewers of Europe**

 The Beer Pledge with 3 pillars: increasing consumer knowledge of beer & its responsible consumption; responsible advertising & marketing; addressing alcohol misuse
