


Outline of WP5 Monitoring health inequalities

Challenges

- The multilevel character (state, regional, local levels; strata within population; etc.) of health inequalities
- How to deal with groups within populations that use to be "invisible" in registers or constitute non-response in surveys, often groups in vulnerable situations such as undocumented migrants, asylum seekers and refugees
- The recruitment of the core expert group – dependent on degree of motivation to allocate resources to the WP
