The objectives of the Work Package are

- i) to support Member States to develop monitoring of health inequalities, well adapted to the national context, and sustainable over time
- ii) to support the development as well as the use of health inequality indicators for health policy evaluation and prioritization
- iii) to suggest health inequality indicators for the EU region and global health monitoring systems.



Challenges

- The multilevel character (state, regional, local levels; strata within population; etc.) of health inequalities
- How to deal with groups within populations that use to be "invisible" in registers or constitute non-response in surveys, often groups in vulnerable situations such as undocumented migrants, asylum seekers and refugees
- The recruitment of the core expert group dependent on degree of motivation to allocate resources to the WP
