





ORGAN TRANSPLANTS IN THE EU - 2011




EUROPEAN UNION DATA




*2011 data

EUROPEAN COMMISSION'S LEGAL MANDATE

Article 168 of the Treaty:

"setting high standards of <u>quality</u> and <u>safety</u> of organs and substances of human origin, blood and blood derivatives"

Directive 2010/53/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council on standards of quality and safety of human organs intended for transplantation

- Adopted on 7 July 2010
- To be transposed by Member States until 27 August 2012

Commission Implementing Directive laying down information procedures for the <u>exchange</u>, between Member States, of human organs intended for transplantation

Aligns communications on organ characterisation (offering), traceability and alerts


Adopted Today (9 October 2012)





DIRECTIVE 2010/53/EU Key elements for quality and safety

• Chain from donation to transplantation, from donor to recipient





- The following areas are **outside of the scope of the Directive:**
 - Consent systems (opt-in / opt-out)
 - Waiting lists
 - Allocation criteria
 - Legislation around brain death
 - \rightarrow The areas remain **national competence**
 - → However, the Commission can encourage Member States to share experiences through collaboration under the Action Plan (voluntary tool)





- International cooperation (Council of Europe, WHO)
- Activities under the **Action Plan** 3 main objectives:
 - \rightarrow increase organ availability
 - \rightarrow improve transplant systems (efficiency and accessibility)
 - \rightarrow improve quality and safety
- Halfway 2009-2015: Mid-term Review


Tools at disposal under the Action Plan:

- > Projects funded under the Public Health Programme
- → Working groups: living donation, indicators, transplant donor coordinators,
- \rightarrow Journalists Workshops





THE ACTION PLAN





Joint action 2011: ACCORD – Assisting Member States in reaching the full potential of deceased and living donation

- Collaboration with ICU experts
- Registers for living donors
- Twinning programmes

Project: "Train the trainers in transplant donor coordination"

- for national/regional/local trainers (80 participants from all Europe)
- to increase organ availability

Project to support cross-border exchanges: COORENOR

- develop an IT tool to offer cross-border organs which can not be used at national level
- encourage cross-border agreements to facilitate organ exchanges
- pilot project is set-up. Preparing for a roll-out (Joint Action)







Organised by Commission in 2010, 2011 and 2012 in Brussels

Objective: increase public awareness

Participation: totally 75 journalists from 26 countries

→ 22 articles/press releases published directly after the 2 first editions

→ and articles submitted under the EU HealthPrize for Journalists


