How is the IT Platform structured?

A general network: **AGORA**



- Is **the common space** for all registered users of the platform
- To discuss **general and cross cutting health issues**
- **To disseminate** information of interest to the Public Health Community

Thematic networks

- Host **discussions** between a group of **stakeholders** having a common interest in a **specific health topic**
- Have a **limited** lifespan (+/-6 months) and lead to the **production of a joint statement** as deliverables
- Are steered by a network **leader** who is one user of the platform, representing an Organisation having a specific expertise in the theme discussed

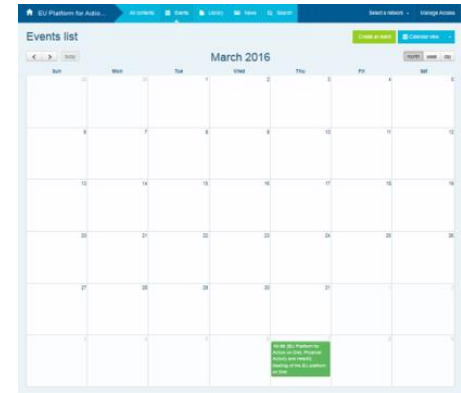


- **Restricted for members** of already established formal or ad-hoc European Commission groups

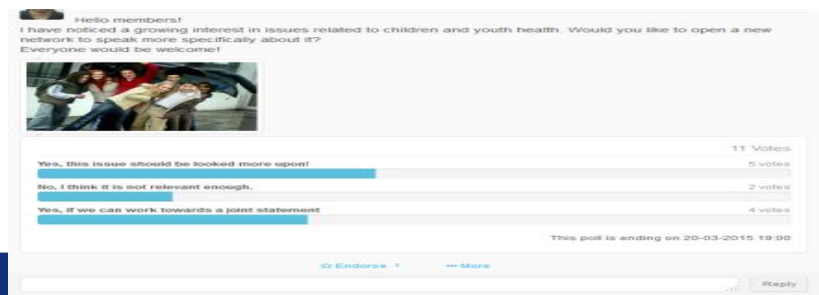

Thematic networks (2)

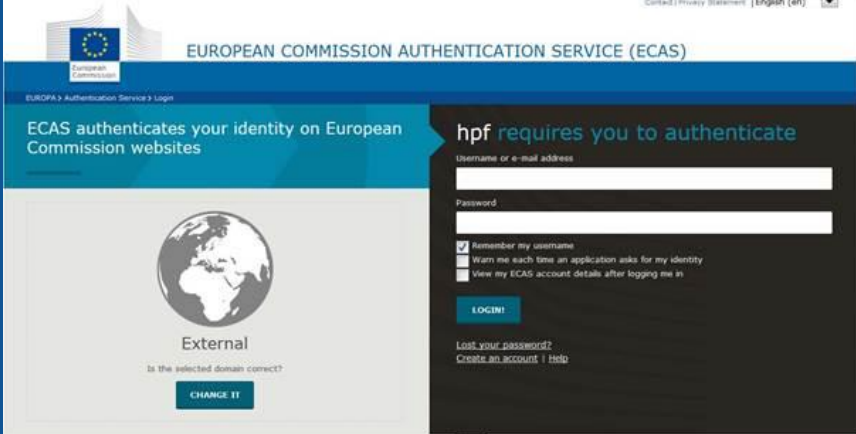
For the first session (April- October 2016), 4 thematic networks have already been opened:
