- Launch event 21st April 2016
- 590 requests of registration to the different Networks and the Agora in the Platform
- 20 active Networks and more to be open





How is the IT Platform structured?

A general network: AGORA



- Is the common space for all registered users of the platform
- To discuss general and cross cutting health issues
- To disseminate information of interest to the Public Health Community

Thematic networks

- Host discussions between a group of stakeholders having a common interest in a specific health topic
 - Have a limited lifespan (+/-6 months) and lead to the production of a joint statement as deliverables
 - Are steered by a network leader who is one user of the platform, representing an Organisation having a specific expertise in the theme discussed







The mentioned interest groups proposed the topics and are leading the discussion in those Thematic Networks.


