



# Cost of Alcohol Misuse to Scotland

#### **Health**

- 42,000 admission
- 1 in 20 deaths
- €315m cost

#### **Economy**

- €1 bn productivity cost
- €4.19 bn total cost 🎉

#### **Safety**

- 50% of prisoners
- 70% of young offenders
- 63% of homicides
- 940 drink driving injuries
- -∕€856m cost

#### Children

- >65,000 children
- 25% of child protection cases
- 1 in 3 divorces
- 62% of domestic abuse

## Challenges

- Systematic & robust data collection
- Identification of alcohol as a contributory factor
- Complexity of factors
- Diagnosis eg. Foetal Alcohol Spectrum Disorder
- Hidden harm
- Awareness of professionals
- Social acceptability of alcohol



### **Effective Responses**

- Affordability
- Availability
- Effective age restrictions & enforcement
- Drink driving
- Responsible marketing:
  - Reduced exposure of young people
  - Avoiding promotions which promote volume consumption
- Workplace policies
- Consumer information labelling/point of sale
- Awareness raising & behaviour change campaigns – eg. pregnancy/drink driving
- Community programmes
- Treatment & early interventions
