## HTA Network Stakeholder Pool Objectives:

- to contribute to the policy development related to HTA at EU level,
- to ensure that the views of different stakeholders are reflected in the policy development in a balanced way,
- to create synergies between different stakeholders.



### Aim of the meeting

- The objective is to come up with concrete proposals for the involvement of health providers in the HTA processes
- The focus of the discussion is expected to be on the current cooperation in the EUnetHTA Joint Action.
- As such the output of the meeting will feed into the HTA Network Multiannual Work Programme 2016-2020,
  - 3.2. Propose arrangements necessary to continue the cooperation after 2020 Rationale
  - 3.3. Discussion paper on how to "facilitate appropriate involvement of all interested stakeholders in the European collaboration in HTA, notably patients, health professionals, healthcare industry, and payers".



## Two levels of stakeholder involvement

- 1) The input provided by <u>experts, in their capacity as</u> <u>individuals</u>, and which brings their specific professional expertise in the development of a product specific output. (e.g. a Joint REA or early dialogues)
- 2) The input provided by <u>stakeholders organisations</u> representing specific constituencies (e.g. healthcare providers, academia, healthcare professionals, patients etc.) and brining in the HTA cooperation the collective expertise/point of the constituency which they represent.
