
Impact of Covid-19 on Cancer diagnosis

Building resilient cancer systems

- All the suffering of cancer patients and professionals will have been for nothing if Europe fails to learn the right lessons from the Covid-19 experience moving forward
- Outlining key recommendations for the future:
 - Resolving the long-term cancer backlog with a view to reach 130% of pre-pandemic cancer systems capacities
 - Urgent and ambitious implementation of the EU Cancer Screening Scheme
 - **EU guidelines on pandemic handling**: trusting the public, empowering the wider community and safeguarding non-crisis care such as cancer care
 - A European Action Plan on health workforce systems resilience: structural pan-European policy addressing of workforce shortages, burnout and mobility issues
 - An annual EMA report on medicines shortages and a Commission study on their root causes with focus on generics
 - An ECDC HPV vaccine tracker inspired from the positive experience of COVID-19 vaccination monitoring
