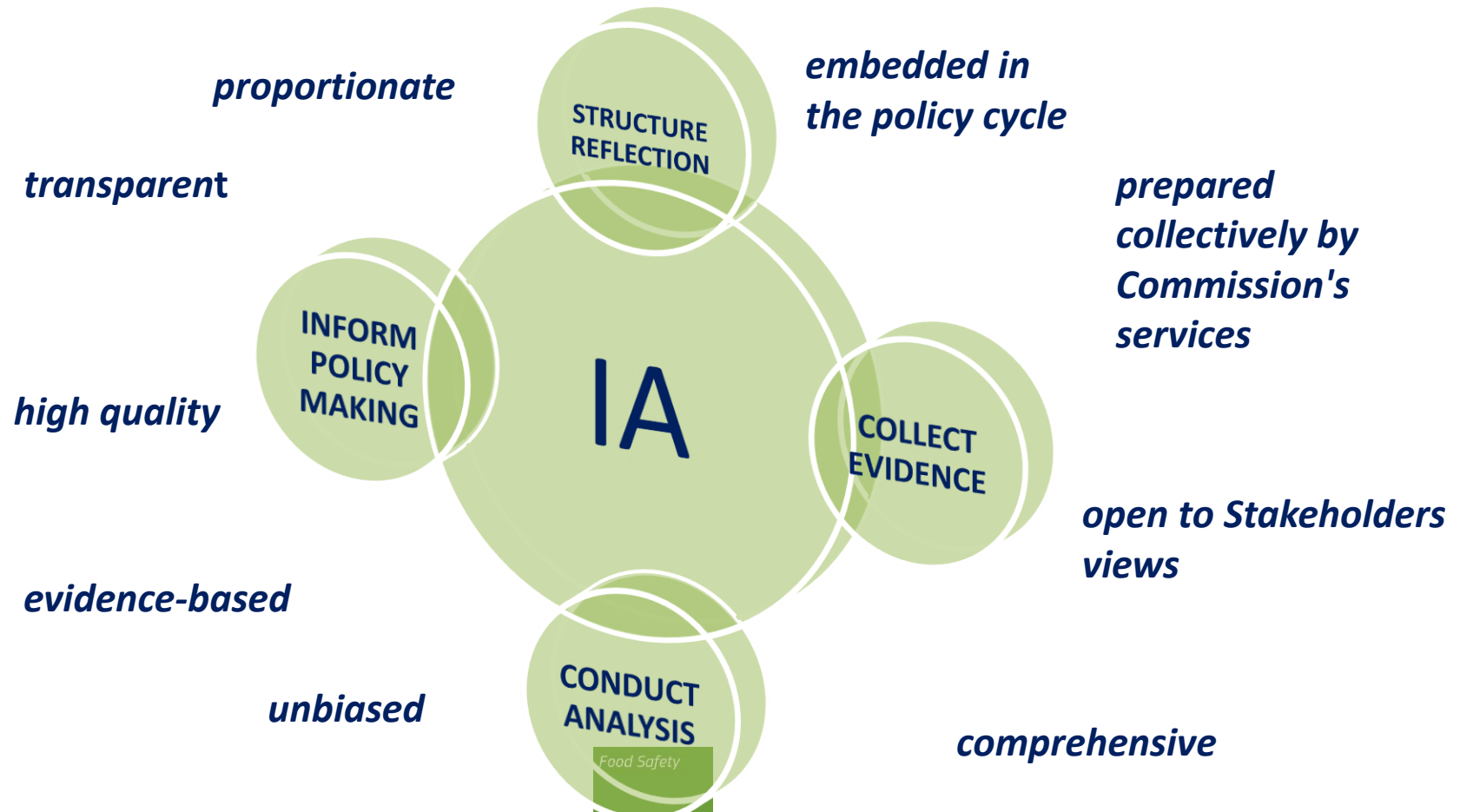

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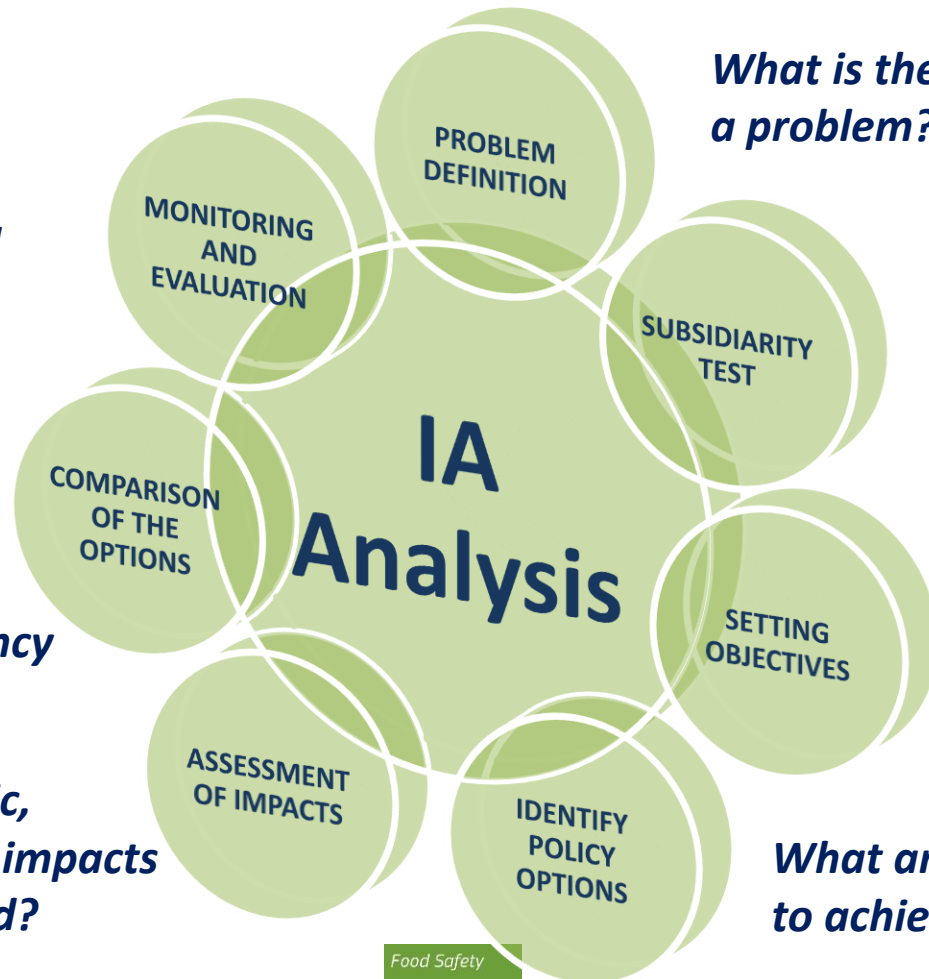
Policy Design using Impact Assessment

What is the problem and why is it a problem?

Why should the EU act?

What should be achieved?

What are the various options to achieve the objectives?

How will monitoring and retrospective evaluation be organised?

Comparison in terms of effectiveness and efficiency

What are their economic, environment and social impacts and who will be affected?



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Impact Assessment: key procedural steps

Creation of the ISG and finalisation of the Roadmap/ Inception IA

**Collection and analysis of data and expertise
Stakeholders Consultations**

Drafting of the Impact Assessment Report

Quality Screening by the RSB

Adaptation of the Report to the opinion to the RSB opinion

Inter Services Consultation
