1. WELCOME AND APOLOGIES

The Chair of the working group (WG) welcomed the participants and communicated the apologies received.

The working group continued the discussion on the Commission's request to clarify whether the safety concerns raised in the justification for Danish ban of propyl and butyl parabens in cosmetic products for children up to three years of age are scientifically justified. The conclusions of the discussion will be included in a response document to be approved in the SCCS Plenary of 20 September.
