What is a Commission expert group?

A consultative body:

- set up by the Commission to provide them with advice and expertise
- composed of public and/or private sector members
- meets more than once





Role of a Commission expert group

To advise the Commission on:

- the preparation of legislative proposals and policy initiatives
- the preparation of delegated acts

- the implementation of EU legislation, programmes and policies, including coordination and cooperation with Member States and stakeholders





Why we need rules of procedure

Article 17

Rules of procedure

1. Expert groups and sub-groups shall adopt rules of procedures by simple majority of its members on a proposal by and in agreement with the competent Commission departments.

For this purpose, Commission departments shall make use of the standard rules of procedure for expert groups.
