Subject: WP2011 Priority "Chronic conditions"

Procurement following a call for tender

Mapping exercise of existing European population-based registries for major and chronic diseases and evaluation of their possible interoperability and integration.

Subject:

- 1) Mapping of all population-based registries in the area of major and chronic diseases. Setting up of a network of all existing European and national registries for major and chronic diseases.
- 2) Evaluation of the registries for their possible interoperability and integration into one European-wide registry for major and chronic diseases.
- 3) Definition of sets of common indicators and rules for coding, reporting, quality assurance and analysis for major and chronic diseases based on ECHI/EUHI should be developed.
- 4) This should comprise the 4 basic indicators, incidence, mortality, prevalence and survival. In addition, the indicators for quality of life linked to specific major and chronic disease morbidity should be analysed and collected if appropriate.
- 4) The European network of cancer registries should serve as a model in conjunction with the existing European networks, which have developed or currently develop major and chronic disease registries in specific disease groups, e.g., cardiovascular diseases, diabetes, or else.

Deliverables

Three conferences (ex-ante, midterm and ex-post), a report, a set of recommendations, a pilot implementation and a web portal on the project describing a European registry for all major and chronic diseases including cancer, proposing the way forward how to achieve it, providing for a first pilot implementation, and last but not least providing a web portal documenting the entire prerequisites and progress and achievements of the project.

To be completed in 36 month for a budget of Euro 2.6 million.
