Success of vaccination


- Eradication of smallpox
- Near eradication of polio



- Prevention of estimated 2.5 million deaths each year worldwide.
- 94 % decrease of measles cases since 1980.
- Estimated 74 % reduction in measles deaths over the last 10 years.
- Seasonal influenza vaccination currently prevents up to 37.000 deaths each year in the EU.




Vaccination policy in Europe is <u>not</u> achieving its public health goals




Underestimated
