Election procedure

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Election of Chairs and Vice-Chairs of the Scientific Committees

- Each Scientific Committee shall elect from among its members a Chair and two Vice-Chairs.
- The terms of office of the Chair and Vice-Chairs shall be <u>three</u> <u>years</u>, **renewable**.
- A <u>separate record</u> shall be kept of the election procedure. The <u>names</u> of the Chair and the two Vice-Chairs of each of the Committees shall be <u>made public</u>.
- The Chair and Vice Chairs shall be <u>elected by secret ballot and</u> <u>in writing</u>.
- The election procedure shall be chaired by the Commission.





Procedure

- The <u>election</u> of the <u>Chair</u> and of each of the <u>Vice Chairs</u> shall be held <u>separately</u>
- The <u>names of candidates</u> are notified to the Secretariat
- Members may present themselves as candidates or propose another member
- <u>Declaration from candidates</u> prior to the vote
- The candidate receiving the <u>majority of the votes</u> of the present members of the Committees shall be <u>elected</u>





Procedure

- <u>If none</u> of the candidates receives the majority, <u>a second</u> <u>ballot</u> shall be held <u>between the two candidates with the</u> <u>highest</u> individual totals of <u>votes</u> in the first ballot. The procedure shall be <u>repeated</u> until one candidate obtains the majority of the votes of the members of the Committee.
- <u>Candidates may withdraw their candidature</u> at any time during the procedure.
- Where there is or remains <u>a single candidate</u>, that candidate shall be elected provided that he/she receives the <u>majority of votes cast</u>





Role of Chairs and Vice-Chairs

- <u>Planning the work</u> of the Committee in agreement with the Secretariat.
- <u>Chairing, steering and moderating the discussions</u> at meetings and <u>drawing conclusions</u>.
- <u>Examining the declarations of interest</u> and action in order to ensure the effective application of the <u>independence</u> requirements
- In collaboration with the Secretariat, <u>monitoring the conformity</u> <u>of the activities</u> of the Committee and taking, or requesting the Commission to take as appropriate, the necessary measures
- Representing the Committee





Replacement of Chairs and Vice-Chairs

- The <u>Chair shall be replaced by one of the Vice-Chairs</u> or, failing that, another member chosen in common accord by the members.
- In case of <u>conflict of interest of the Chair with an item on the agenda</u>, he/she shall be replaced by <u>one of the Vice-Chairs</u> or failing that another member chosen in common accord by the members.
- The Vice-chairs will support the Chair in fulfilling his or her responsibilities. The <u>Chair will consult the Vice-chairs on a regular basis</u> and as appropriate on emerging issues.
- <u>Conflict of Interest (CoI)</u> meaning a situation when an individual is in a position to exploit his or her own professional or official capacity in some way for personal or corporate benefit with regard to that person's function in the context of his or her cooperation with Scientific Committees
