Actions with international organisations and EU Agencies (indirect management) cut across the DG SANTE activities. In addition to these allocations, mental health has also been supported by about EUR 27,8 million worth of investments under the 2021 and 2022 work programmes. International health actions worth around EUR 20,8 million investments are ongoing from the 2021 and 2022 work programme.
